WOODWIND & BRASS (1 - 4)

> STRINGS (5-8)

Violinists may also play from Parts 1 & 2. Bass Guitarists may also play from the chord symbols on Part 12.

PERCUSSION & GUITARS (9 - 12)

The Tuned Percussion, Part 9, also includes the melody which is shown is small notes. Less experienced players may use Part 11.

The Unpitched Percussion, Part 10, may be played by any suitable instrument, though suggestions are given.
