This 1972 US No.1 lasts for nearly nine minutes and is considered a really important song in the history of American music. Don McLean has never explained the true meaning behind the lyrics, though they seem to refer to specific events. The line, 'the day the music died', is thought to refer to the day that Buddy Holly (among other musicians) died in a plane crash.

Hints & Tips: Whilst the rhythm of the right hand is quite complex, the rhythm of the left hand is very repetitive.

Try to be aware of this when first playing both parts together.
