> Comment in the first edition (translation): The editors [= Florestan and Eusebius] apply pedalling to more or less all measures depending on the given harmonies. Exceptions, where no pedalling is desired, are marked ? [= H] as soon as the sign “Pedale” appears, constant use of the pedal is to be resumed.

> Remarque dans la première édition (traduction): Les éditeurs [Florestan et Eusebius] utilisent la pédale dans presque chaque mesure, selon que l'exigent les séquences harmoniques. Les exceptions sont caractérisées par ? [= H], là où le jeu de la pédale doit cesser totalement; l'utilisation permanente de la pédale reprend à partir de l'indication «Pedale».
