PROGRAM NOTES

Although generally defined as any sheltered or growth stage of development, a chrysalis in it's fundamental meaning is the third stage of growth in the development of a butterfly. Following the egg and larva stages, the chrysalis stage is a dormant, quiet period where the adult features of the butterfly are developed. After this growth stage, the adult emerges from the pupa and takes to the sky as a fully developed butterfly.
