Toy Symphony (First Movement)

Leopold Mozart's *Toy Symphony* is a delight for the performer and audience alike. This delightful piece from the early classical period shows the same whimsical and carefree style in which his son, Wolfgang, would later begin composing. The solo parts for toys can be performed easily by band members on "real" instruments (for example, using clarinet or oboe for the cuckoo and a pair of clarinets or oboes for the train whistle) or by anyone else on actual toys. You could feature parents, other teachers or even your principal on these parts.

To the director:

The commercially available cuckoo whistles can be tuned to the correct pitches by adding a small quantity of water.
