NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

From the highly anticipated finale of Christopher Nolan's Batman trilogy, Zimmer's dynamic and exciting music brings the story to life. This medley, featuring "Rise," "On Thin Ice," and "Imagine the Fire," will thrill your orchestra and audiences alike.

The percussion throughout this arrangement is a consolidation of several electronic drum tracks/timbres. Percussion 1 (two players) also calls for rhythms to be performed on the shell (sides) of a deep drum or snare drum. You may also consider playing this part on the rim of a snare drum. The performer on bass drum will need to use two mallets. Percussion 2 is to be performed by two percussionists with one player on the upper toms (stems up) and one player on the lower toms (stems down). The larger the concert toms are, the better. You may substitute a Taiko Drum for the lowest tom part. Though this arrangement includes standard instrumentation, should you look to be as faithful to the original score as possible, then the following instrumentation may be used: all strings, piano, all percussion, French horns, trombones, and tuba.

NOTE FROM THE EDITOR

All Belwin string parts have been carefully bowed and fingered appropriately by level. The Yellow Very Beginning series includes many bowings as well as reminder fingerings for first-time readers. The Red Beginning series includes frequent bowings to assist younger players. Fingerings for altered pitches are often marked. The Green Intermediate series includes appropriately placed bowings for middle-level students. Fingerings and positions are marked for notes beyond first position. The Blue Concert series includes bowings appropriate for the experienced high school player. Fingerings and position markings are indicated for difficult passages.
